Dear Ms. Debbie Hancock,

I trust that you are well, and this email finds you well.

The purpose of this email is to seek consideration for my family and, at this particular time, my sons, Joseph and John.

Moving here in December 2008, there have been a number of incidents involving the Rankin County Sherriff's office with my family and on my property.

When I say, this "runs deep," it runs deeper than just on the surface.

Those who are to "protect and to serve" have been serving a brand of justice that is outside the boundaries of human decency and dignity. They have violated my family on more than one occasion over the years and therefore this is why I am seeking your intervention in this matter.

A number of these incidents are documented in my book.

I have been in contact with Jason Dare, Atty for Rankin County. We have established communication and a good rapport. In short, I've attached a copy of my letter to the Sheriff, mailed today.

During our conversations I have made suggestions of merit. This is then why I am writing. My suggestion is that there should be an investigation going back as long ago as any of these officers were carrying a badge. This behavior began at some point and cultivated. In short, there are those incarcerated over these years due to said injustices on those who are innocent. This should include clearing the records of those who were falsely accused. You must understand we are talking about reputations and damage inflicted on innocent citizens. Even more sinister for those who may have been guilty of a lesser crime, charges were manipulated and escalated causing a domino effect. Know this, it runs deeper than on the surface.

This is a mess that must be cleaned up. Justice is required in a swift manner.

Before going to the FBI, at this point with my grievances-information, I felt it imperative I approach your office.

Dearl Honorable Sheriff,

I am writing regarding the "Goon Squad."

For many years, as you know my son John and on at least one occasion Joseph has had contact with this unprofessional behavior.

In short, there were several occasions where officers exceeded their boundaries and violated my sons' rights. These include threatening, verbal, and physical abuse, and harassment. Both of my sons, especially John, are and have been in fear for their life.

As you can imagine, this has been "under" the radar according to your statement for years. You can be sure these issues have caused long term affect with not only my sons but other victims of these crimes. Are we to trust the police? Who is policing the police? I can tell you I, myself, was threatened in 2020 on my own property in an encounter when several "squad" cars were on my property with officers accusing my son, John, of something he did not do. John was at Waffle house, but they appeared and continued to threaten him and then began to threaten me while parked on my property because I told them he was where he said he was. This "interrogation" went on for what seemed like an hour. Eventually, they left but without any apology nor feeling of not knowing if "they" would return.

There were other incidents where my son, Joseph, was not only threatened, slapped, but hauled him off to jail after they searched my home illegally. They charged him with finding a kitchen scale, calling it illegal. It doesn't change the fact he did nothing.

We should discuss these incidents because John was terrorized so much, he left the county in fear of his life. This fear caused him to leave this county which caused a cascading effect acceleration legal implication. These domino effects need to be addressed.

As a case in point, I would ask that we investigate his treatment in 2020 when Flowood took him to the hospital. He was choked by Flowood Officers in front of the examining doctor. The doctor just watched and cheered it on. Therefore, this "goon squad" has had long term implications deep into not only Rankin County but Madison and Hinds County as well as the City of Flowood. John can elaborate.

There is more "terror" that has happened over the years, and this is what I wish to discuss with you. Counseling and other services should be offered as well as an investigation of all those incarcerated and having had to plead to trumped up charges.

No one was "credible" in the past in terms of horrific actions taken against the citizenry.

My understanding is you have had no knowledge of these activities. Therefore, I feel it is imperative that we engage in a discussion for managing issues such as PTSD and counseling for those victims as well as reopening these cases. My contention is there are those incarcerated unlawfully.

I do seek an investigation of these actions with an understanding that the citizen is considered innocent rather than guilty first.

Your attention to this matter is requested.
