_____ in Rankin County, Mississippi, and hereby makes an application to Rankin County for the construction permit. Attached hereto are drawings or plans for construction, which will not be changed or altered without the approval of the Board of Supervisors, or its authorized representative.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of Mississippi has heretofore granted to the Applicant the right to locate its facilities upon, across, under, over, and along public highways and streets within the State of Mississippi. Applicant agrees to comply with applicable provisions of the Policy for the Accommodation of Utility Facilities within the Rights-of-Way of all Public County Roads (hereinafter referred to as the " Policy" promulgated by the State Aid Engineer on January 17, 1972), and which is hereby made a part of this Application Agreement and agreed to perform the construction according to the applicable industry code and according to the plans and specification for the Project.

The Applicant shall be responsible for future maintenance and repairs of the facilities. Applicant agrees to comply with applicable provisions of the Policy for the Accommodation of Utility Facilities within the Rights-of-Way of all Public County Roads (hereinafter referred to as the "Policy" promulgated by the State Aid Engineer on January 17, 1972), and which is hereby made a part of this Application Agreement, and agreed to perform the construction according to the applicable industry code and according to the plans and specification for the Project.

The Applicant shall be responsible for future maintenance and repairs of the facilities. The Applicant shall make future adjustments in, or relocate, the facilities then required for maintenance or improvements of public county roads. The Applicant shall receive no compensation for future adjustments or relocations of the facilities as a result of maintenance to or improvement of public county roads. By applying for this permit, the Applicant acknowledges and agrees that it shall make adjustments to or relocation of the facilities within a period of sixty (60) days from the date requested to do so by Rankin County, the failure of which shall result in a withdrawal of Applicant's rights hereunder. Further, any maintenance, repair, or construction shall be done in such a manner as to occasion the least possible interference with the normal flow and safety of traffic.

A general description of the size, type, nature, and extent of the Utility work to be done is as follows:

The Applicant understands and agrees that, except as herein stated, no right, title, claim or easement to said road right-of-way is granted by the issuance of this permit and that if this Utility Facility is not placed within the allowable horizontal and vertical limits as listed in the general provisions of the Policy, it will be adjusted to comply with same without cost to the County, unless the variance from the Policy has been approved by the granting of the Permit pursuant to this Application.

The Applicant further understands that the Utility's engineering plant, or other personnel will be responsible for the staking and construction supervision of the work set out above and as shown on the attached plans.

Rankin County intends the following:

1. Cooperate with the Utility Company to avoid unnecessary conflicts in locating, constructing, and maintaining County Roads and Utilities.
2. Use legal means to see that Policy Standards, except to the extent of any variance shown on the plans filed herewith and approved, are complied with in the facility installation.
3. If the County Engineer or other authorized representative of the Board of Supervisors approves the drawings, sketches, and plans submitted by the Applicant, he shall so indicate by signing and dating the Permit Approval at the end of this Application, and the sketches, and plans are not approved, he shall promptly notify the applicant, and advise it of the reason or reasons. He will also act as the duly appointed representative of the Board of Supervisors and will give his approval to the completed work as being in the compliance with the location and standards shown in the Policy in this Agreement for the installation.
4. Should any term or provision of the Application Agreement conflict with the law of the State of Mississippi, the Mississippi Constitution, or the United States Constitution, or impair or deny to the Applicant or the County any right protected thereby, it shall be deemed amended to conform to said law or Constitution.

By submitting this Application, the Applicant CERTIFIES to Rankin County as follows:

1. Applicant has researched Mississippi 811 records and certifies that all existing utilities within the limits of the project that lie in the county right-of-way covered by this permit application are shown on this permit application, complete with type and owner of existing utility, and;
2. The owners of all existing utilities within the limits of the project that lie in the county right-of-way covered by this permit application have been provided with a copy of this permit application for informational purposes only, and;
3. That the proposed utility covered by this permit application will be installed at a minimum horizontal distance of eighteen inches (18") from any other existing utility OR, if eighteen inch (18") horizontal clearance is not maintained, Applicant agrees to waive any rights to compensation for repair of the proposed utility covered by this permit application for any non-negligent damage to the utility covered by this permit application caused by the operation and maintenance activities of any utility operator of an existing utility shown on this permit application that lies closer than eighteen inches (18") horizontally to the utility covered under this permit application; AND,

4. That Applicant waives any and all right to compensation from Rankin County for removal of, relocating of, or future damage caused by Rankin County to, any utility placed as a result of this Application.
5. Applicant will abide by each provision and term as reflected on the **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

RANKIN COUNTY UTILITY PERMIT

The permit for the installation or adjustment of the utilities applied for is granted under the authority of the Rankin County Board of Supervisors Road Right-of-Way permit policy. The following conditions must be satisfied in order for this Permit to remain valid:

1. Applicant and/or Contractor performing services must display a minimum 20 inch by 20 inch sign indicating the name of the applicant and the name of the contractor performing services (if applicable) at an obvious and visible location in close proximity to the location where utilities are being installed/relocated.
2. A copy of the approved utility permit application and a copy of this Permit must be placed in all vehicles utilized by Applicant and/or Contractor.
3. All Utilities must be buried to a depth that provides a minimum of 5 feet of cover over the utility. Any utilities found to have been located or relocated at a shallower depth shall be relocated to the proper depth by the Applicant at Applicant's sole expense within thirty (30) days from the date upon which the applicant is notified of the violation. Note that for utility placement or relocation resulting from a county road construction project, all utilities shall be buried to a depth that provides a minimum of 5 feet of cover over the utility based on the final grades achieved at completion of the road project. Utilities that are located or relocated in violation of these requirements shall subject Applicant to reimbursement of Rankin County for any and all damages incurred by Rankin County occasioned thereby. Any applicant failing to meet the requirements of this paragraph 3 or any other requirement of this permit shall be refused a permit in the future until such time as the violation has been cured or the damages reimbursed to the satisfaction of Rankin County.
4. Any Utility that crosses a county road must be incased.
5. The Applicant shall provide CAD FORMAT (or other appropriate digital format suitable for county use), AS BUILT DRAWINGS DEPICTING DESCRIPTION, LOCATION AND DEPTH OF ALL INSTALLED UTILITIES to the Rankin County Road Manager and the Rankin County Consulting Engineer. A ".pdf" version of as built drawings must be delivered to the Rankin County Administrator at project completion.

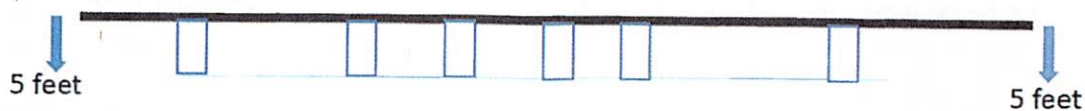

Utility Contractor Requirements & Responsibilities:

- 1) Fill out a utility permit form entirely and include the following:
 - a) Permits in the back 8 foot Right of Way do not require detailed drawings, only an outline drawing of the project with enough detail to denote which side of the road the utility will be placed.
 - b) Detailed drawings are required when work is outside the back 8 foot of Right of Way and shall provide enough detail with dimensions from existing features so that the install location can be easily field reviewed.
 - c) Verification of utility easements for subdivision is the contractor's responsibility.
 - d) Submit entire utility permit package to utpermit@rankincounty.org
- 2) Once approved by the Board of Supervisors the Contactor will be notified via email from Janice Dendy.
 - a) After receiving the approved utility permit all correspondence will be utpermit@rankincounty.org
 - b) 48 hours notice form is required to utpermit email address before the start date of work.
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 - e) All excavators MUST be smooth mouthed buckets only (teeth buckets Not allowed).
 - f) One Boring Rig is allowed six pits within a 48-hour time frame.
 - g) Boring holes will only be at a depth of 5 feet
 - h) When not actively working open holes wrap with orange safety construction fencing.
 - i) All task completed by 5 pm during weekdays. All pits will be closed over the weekend and Holidays.
 - j) Holes will be filled with compactable dirt or select material.
 - k) Anything impeding the roadway will be filled with crushed aggregate.



- 4) Upon completion of the work, as-built drawings in PDF format shall be submitted to the Rankin County Road Manager within 90 days of completed utility installation.
 - a) The minimum required detail of the as-built drawings shall be the same as required with the original permit submittal. If utility installation is outside the area of the approved permitting location, the contractor will be responsible for removing and relocating the utilities.
- 5) Suspension of Permit:
 - a) If damage occurs at worksite the permit will be suspended for 2 business days.

5) Suspension of Permit:

- a) If damage occurs at worksite the permit will be suspended for 2 business days.
- b) The second occurrence of damage at the worksite will result in a 5 business day suspension.
- c) The third occurrence of damage at the worksite will result in termination of the utility permit, complete operational shutdown and equipment removal. The contractor will have to meet with the county Board a Supervisor for approval of future operations within the county.

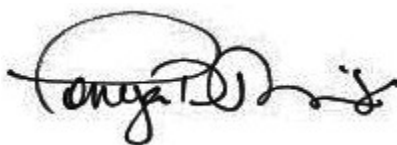
